Communicant members of other churches are welcome to receive the Sacrament (given in one kind only.) If you would like a blessing, please cross your hands across your chest.

Priest My brothers and sisters, to prepare ourselves to celebrate the Sacred Mysteries, let us call to mind our sins: *see bulletin. At end:*

Priest May Almighty God have Mercy on us, forgive us our sins and bring us to everlasting life.

All **Amen**

Gloria *(song of praise - said)*

Glorify to God in the highest, and peace to His people on earth. Lord God, heavenly King, Almighty God and Father: we worship you, we give you thanks, we praise you for your glory.

Lord Jesus Christ, only Son of the Father: Lord God, Lamb of God, you take away the sin of the world: have mercy on us. You are seated at the right hand of the Father: receive our prayer.

For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

STAND **Creed** (Profession of Faith) *Either:*

❖ **NICENE CREED**

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten not made, of one Being with the Father. Through him all things were made.

For us men and for our salvation He came down from Heaven; *(all bow)* by the power of the Holy Spirit he became incarnate from the Virgin Mary, and was made man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in Glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son He is worshipped and glorified. He has spoken through the prophets.

We believe in one holy catholic and Apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen

Or:

❖ **APOSTLES CREED**

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and the life everlasting. Amen

KNEEL **The Eucharistic Prayer** *continues, in which the bread and wine are consecrated to become the body and blood of Christ.*

After Consecration:

Priest Let us proclaim the mystery of faith:

All **Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again.**

Priest *continues Eucharistic Prayer, ending: Through him, with him, in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honour is yours, Almighty Father, for ever and ever.*

All **Amen.**

The Lord's Prayer
